

4. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The fridge runs at 230V/50Hz. Abnormal voltage fluctuations may cause the fridge unable to start or burning of control panel, compressor or abnormal noise from compressor, in such case it is advisable to use voltage stabilizer.





The power cord is designed with three wire plug to suit three pin sockets only, don't discard the third wire plug to insert in two pin sockets. Also make sure of grounding, improper grounding may cause breakdown or electric shock.



Don't disconnect the power plug by pulling the cord, instead hold on the plug firmly and pull

out from the socket.


Don't step on the power cord.

Don't allow power cord be pressed by heavy objects Don't touch power cord with wet hands.





Don't use damaged power cord or plug.





While cleaning the fridge, keep its interior parts out of reach of children to avoid any damage.





4. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

In case of gas leakage, don't touch the power outlet and ventilate the room immediately.



Disconnect the power plug before cleaning or repairing. (repairing to be done by authorized repair personnel only)



Do not use or store inflammable, explosives, corrosive, alkali materials near or in the fridge. Do not store non-domestic purpose medicines or chemicals.

When you disconnect the power cord for cleaning or repairing purpose, reconnect it after at least 5 minutes to avoid compressor damage due to quick transition between ON/OFF states.







Do not use combustible spray near fridge to prevent fire.



Do not keep any other electric appliances or heavy, unstable objects or liquid containers on top of the fridge.





Do not cling or hold on tightly to the door or its shelves to avoid any damage. Especially refrain children from doing the same.



Do not touch freezer interior and ice box with wet hands to avoid frostbite.





Use handle to open and close the door. Don't allow children to play with the door.



Do not place fridge in wet or humid area where water or rain drops can splash on the fridge.





Disassembling, repairing or any alterations to the fridge should be done by authorized repair personnel only.

Do not put bottled liquid in the freezer compartment, it may freeze the contents and cause frost-cracking. Close bottle caps tightly if storing horizontally, to avoid leakage that may cause ice formation/sweating issues.




5. PRODUCT INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

Level the fridge so that it rests firm on the floor, to do this there are two front adjustable legs, one at each front corner. Turn to the left to raise a corner and to the right to lower the corner.

If you want the fridge door to close when not held open, adjust the front legs in such a way that front of the fridge is raised

If you want the fridge door to remain motionless when held open, adjust the front legs in such a way that all four corners are leveled with each other.



Fridge should be placed at a distance from any heat source or direct sunlight.


High surrounding temperature will lower the cooling efficiency and increase your electricity bill.



Avoid places that are exposed to smoke. The exterior paint may decolor.




Fridge should not be placed in extremely cold environment ($<10~^{\circ}$ C).



Fridge should be placed in well-ventilated area, maintain at least 20 cm distance from all the sides of the fridge.



Placing the fridge on the carpet may develop heat and discolor the appliance. In such case, put a hard wooden board or a rubber mat between the fridge and the carpet.



6. BASIC INSTALLATION STEPS

1) Remove all the packing material such as packing box, packing bag, all cushions, bottom EPS and adhesive tapes from both exterior and interior of the fridge.



2) Read user guide manual carefully.



3) Install fridge at proper location and make sure leveling is done (refer product installation guidelines).



4) Gently wipe off interior and exterior of the fridge with soft cloth, while doing this try to keep doors open for some time to get rid of plastic smell, however this smell will go away when fridge is cooled sufficiently.



5) After leveling and cleaning wait for at least 2 hours before putting power ON, this is to ensure compressor gas stabilization.



6) Tear off transparent film cover from the fridge cabinet body to ensure heat dissipation and power consumption optimization.



7) It is recommended to keep freezer and refrigerator compartment temperature settings to normal mode right after you plug in for the first time.

8) Later on, control the temperatures of freezer and refrigerator compartments through display control panel.

9) After power ON wait for at least 3-4 hours before storing food.



Install the fridge where the temperature is 10°C to 43°C. If your refrigerator is installed in too low or high temperature, the internal cooling system may not work properly.

7. HOW TO OPERATE

7.1 Temperature Setting Guide

a) Refrigerator Compartment Temperature Setting

Ref.

Press 'Ref.' button once, the temperature indicator area will begin to blink.

Press 'Ref.' button again to change the temperature from the range 02°C to 08°C.

Inactivity of 5 seconds will fix the temperature to the displayed number, after this the indicator area will stop blinking and will show actual temperature in the refrigerator compartment.

SEASON WISE TEMPERATURE SETTING GUIDE

Summer: $02^{\circ}\text{C} \sim 04^{\circ}\text{C}$, Monsoon: $04^{\circ}\text{C} \sim 05^{\circ}\text{C}$, Winter: $06^{\circ}\text{C} \sim 07^{\circ}\text{C}$

Note: In winter season if ambient temperature goes below 5°C, it is recommended to set refrigerator compartment temperature within the range 2°C ~ 3°C to ensure proper cooling performance.

b) Freezer Compartment Temperature Setting

Frz.

Press 'Frz.' button once, the temperature indicator area will begin to blink.


Press 'Frz.' button again to change the temperature from the range -13°C to -21°C.

Inactivity of 5 seconds will fix the temperature to the displayed number, after this the indicator area will stop blinking and will show actual temperature in the freezer compartment.

SEASON WISE TEMPERATURE SETTING GUIDE

Summer: -19° C $\sim -21^{\circ}$ C, Monsoon: -16° C $\sim -18^{\circ}$ C, Winter: -13° C $\sim -15^{\circ}$ C

7. HOW TO OPERATE



7.2 Function Setting Guide

- a) Super Freezer: To set freezer compartment into Super Freezer mode, press and hold 'Frz.' button until 'SF' is displayed. To exit this mode press 'Frz.' button and set freezer compartment temperature as per your requirement.
- b) Super Cooling: To set refrigerator compartment into Super Cooling mode, press and hold 'Ref.' button until 'SC' is displayed. To exit this mode press 'Ref.' button and set refrigerator compartment temperature as per your requirement.
- c) Energy Saving: To put ON Energy Saving mode, press and hold 'Energy Saving' button for 3 seconds. The energy saving symbol will glow. To exit this mode press 'Energy Saving' button.
- **d) Convertible:** To put ON Convertible mode i.e. to convert freezer compartment into refrigerator compartment, press and hold 'R/F' button for 3 seconds. The convertible symbol will glow. To exit this mode press 'R/F' button.
- e) Ref Off: To turn refrigerator compartment off and keep only freezer compartment working, press and hold 'Ref.' button until 'OF' is displayed. During this mode, REF compartment will maintain 22°C ~ 25°C. To turn ON refrigerator compartment again press 'Ref.' button once and set temperature as per your requirement.
- f) Frz Off: To turn freezer compartment off and keep only refrigerator compartment working, press and hold 'Frz.' button until 'OF' is displayed. During this mode, FRZ compartment will maintain -1°C ~ 0°C. To turn ON freezer compartment again press 'Frz.' button once and set temperature as per your requirement.

Once you change temperature settings it needs some time to be stable, this time depends on ambient temperature, door open frequency and temperature of food kept inside.


8. FOOD STORAGE GUIDELINES Do not keep hot food in fridge, bring Wipe off excessive moisture gathered on food or it down to room temperature before containers or bags, this will lead storing it in. This will help to to retain food's freshness for longer time. reduce power consumption. 9. DEFROSTING

Defrosting of freezer compartment is an automatic operation, no manual operation is required.




During defrosting operation the heater turns ON and emit red light which causes freezer compartment look reddish. However, consumers are advised to not to worry as this operation does not cause any harm and will only help your fridge to work efficiently.



10. CLEANING

- 1) Disconnect the power cord.
- 2) In case you want to move the fridge for cleaning, know that it is heavy, make sure you take necessary precautions to protect the floor when moving the fridge. Keep it up right when moving.
- 3) While cleaning exterior, do not use hard brush or harsh cleanser or hot water or acid to clean the fridge. It is recommended to use carbonated solution(4L water with a tablespoon of baking soda). You may use appliance polish or wax to keep the exterior looking like new.
- 4) To clean interior parts of the fridge, use mild soap solution or mild detergent solution.
- 5) To remove door utility racks while cleaning, hold it firmly from both the sides and pull in upward direction. After cleaning place them in exact reverse manner.
- 6) Do not use extreme hot water to clean cold glass shelves to avoid great temperature difference that may lead to glass burst.
- 7) Gaskets are easy to become dirty, users are advised to clean gaskets at least twice a year with mild soap and water, rinse and dry. Apply a light film of petroleum jelly to the gaskets to keep them soft and flexible.
- 8) Please clean the drain tray frequently as water & dust tend to accumulate in it, you can use a dry piece of cloth to absorb accumulated water and avoid water spillage on the floor.

For safety reasons disconnect the power cord before cleaning to avoid the risk of electric shock.

11. GENERAL SUGGESTIONS

1. During power-off

Even during power off, food can remain well for several hours, to ensure this try-

- a) To keep door opening frequency as minimum as possible.
- b) To put ice cubes container at the top side of refrigerator compartment.

2. During disuse

If fridge is not in use for long time-

- a) Disconnect the power cord.
- b) Clean interior properly.
- c) Keep each door open to avoid odour formation.





It is better to not opt for disusing the fridge to avoid shortening of its service life.

11. GENERAL SUGGESTIONS

3. During Holidays

- a) During moderate length holidays, leaving fridge in normal operation is preferable.
- b) During long holiday period, it is recommended to take out all food items, disconnect the power, clean interior properly and leave each door open to prevent adour formation.
- c) To operate again after holidays, keep fridge running for 3-4 hours before storing food.



4. During Shifting

- a) Disconnect the power supply.
- b) Take out all the food items.
- c) Fasten all shelves and boxes of both the compartments with the help of adhesive tape.
- d) Fasten each door with the help of adhesive tape or lock the doors.
- e) For safety reasons it is recommended that two people should carry the fridge and inclination angle shouldn't be more than 45°.
- f) Do not move fridge by holding it's handles.



Prohibited: Never keep the fridge flat parallel to the ground.





12. FACTS

During summer, increase in power consumption is normal due to increase in amount of food storage, door opening frequency and ambient temperature.

Condensing pipe is situated at sides, back & top of Refrigerator internally, it is used to extract heat from the interior to outside air due to which exterior surface may get hot however o it is totally normal condition & does not affect performance of the product.

Water drops may appear on the exterior of the fridge when air humidity is high specially in monsoon season and in coastal cities.



When compressor starts or shuts off, relay may create some switching noise. Also evaporator pipe may create noise during temperature changes.

Memory Backup - In case of power failures, your fridge will always keep last temperature and function settings in memory and will start working again with same settings as soon as power turns ON.

13. BASIC TROUBLESHOOTING BY YOURSELF

Problem Description	Probable Root Cause	What you can do ?
	Power supply off	Check fridge's main supply plug is connected to the socket and the switch is ON.
Fridge does not work	House fuse blown.	Get this fixed with the help of an electrician.
WOIK	Stabilizer does not work.	Try connecting power plug directly to the wall socket, if it works then get the stabilizer fixed by repairing centre.
Fridge attempts to start but fails to operate.	Insufficient voltage supply.	Install a voltage stabilizer in the mains with the help of an electrician.
	Improper temperature setting of freezer/refrigerator compartments.	Set refrigerator compartment temperature between coldest range $06 \sim 08$ however Super Cooling (SC) mode will be the coldest. Set freezer compartment temperature between -18 \sim -21 however Super Freeze (SF) mode will be the coldest.
	Hot food storage.	Avoid storing hot food as it is, let them be at room temperature before keeping them inside the fridge.
Low Cooling	Insufficient space for cool air circulation.	Maintain some distance between food containers, do not cover fridge interior parts with cloth or plastic sheets.
	Door not closed properly.	Make sure to close door properly after every time you open it.
	High door opening frequency	Reduce door opening frequency, as it allows ambient hot air to get inside.
	Refrigerator placed near to heat source.	Do not install fridge near to oven or room heater or in contact with direct sunlight.
	Lack of ventilation in area surrounded by fridge.	Maintain at least 20 cm distance from all sides of the fridge.
Over Cooling	Improper temperature setting of freezer/refrigerator compartments.	Set refrigerator compartment temperature between $02 \sim 05$. Set freezer compartment temperature between $-13 \sim -15$.
	Fridge leveling not done.	Adjust levels by rotating front two legs of the fridge.
Noise	Normal relay switch ON/OFF noise.	Whenever fridge starts or stops working, cut-in or cut-off noise gets generated from relay located in compressor. Generation of this noise is a absolutely normal condition.
Odour	Poorly wrapped food.	Wrap food items properly, close box lids and bottle caps tightly. Make sure utensils are covered with their lid. Clean regularly.
Formation of water drops on exterior of fridge.	High humidity in atmosphere.	Specially during monsoon season atmospheric humidity increases and hence there are chances of water drops formation on exterior of fridge, make sure you wipe off this moisture regularly to ensure product's performance.
Poor ice formation	Improper temperature setting of freezer compartment.	For quicker ice or ice-cream formation, set the freezer compartment to Super Freeze (SF) mode.
Ice cubes have odour / taste	Unsealed packages in the freezer compartment may be transmitting odour / taste to the ice cubes or Interior needs cleaning.	Ice tray and ice collecting box to be emptied and washed, clean interior frequently.
LED / Lamp not working	LED / Lamp is out of order or No power supply.	Call authorized service center for repair or replacement.

- 1. The warranty term will commence and shall automatically terminate on completion of warranty period from the date of invoice.

- 3. Parts replaced or repaired under this warranty are warranted throughout the remaining period of the original warranty.
