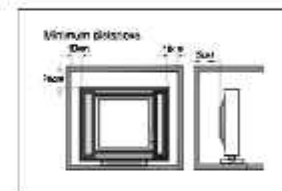
Do not place your television on an unstable cart, stand, shelf or table. Serious injury to an individual, and damage to the television, may result if it falls.

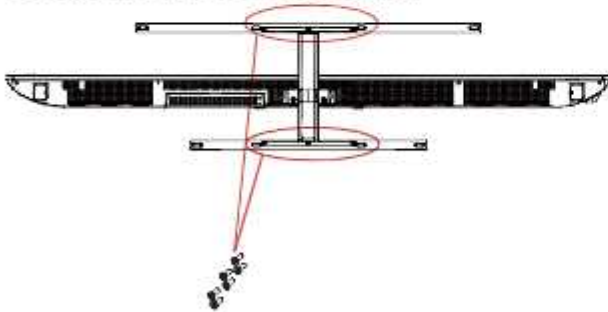
## PREPARATION

**IMPORTANT:** Do not apply pressure to the screen display area which may compromise the integrity of the display. The manufacturer's warranty does not cover user abuse or improper installations.

### ATTACHING THE STAND

**IMPORTANT:** The stand of the TV must be assembled prior to usage.

1. Place TV unit face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc.) to prevent any damage to the TV.
2. Fix the stand to the bottom of the TV with the six screws. And 6 pcs screws to stand.



**NOTE**  
The appearance of the product shall be in kind.

### PREPARING YOUR LED TV FOR WALL MOUNTING

We suggest that you keep your TV at least 2.36 inches (60 mm) from the wall to prevent cable interference. Before mounting your TV on the wall, you need to remove the stand.

For your safety, please use only with a UL listed wall mount bracket with minimum weight of the TV without stand.

To attach a wall mount bracket to your TV:

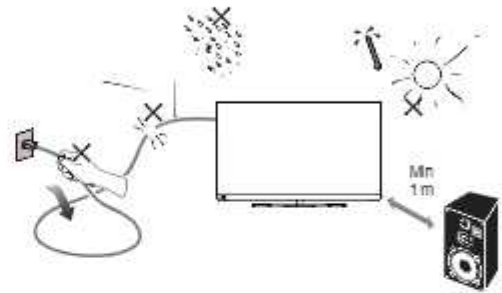
1. Remove the screws holding your TV to the stand.
2. Remove the stand from your TV.
3. Secure the wall mount bracket to the back of your TV using four screws. Follow the instructions of the user manual that came with the wall mount bracket to install.

The wall mount bracket are not included.

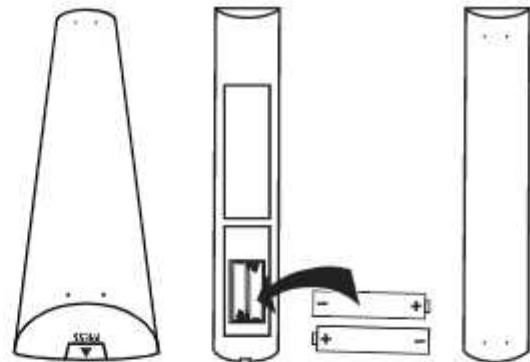
### TURNING ON THE TV

1. Install the stand and place the TV on a solid surface.

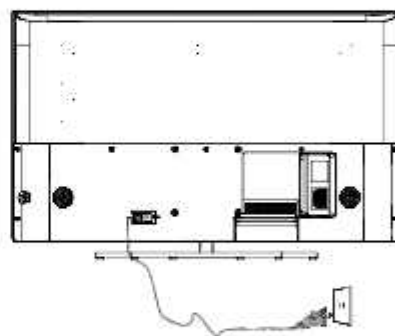



#### NOTE

- Ensure that the TV is placed in a position to allow free flow of air. Do not cover the ventilation openings on the back cover.
  - To prevent any unsafe situations, no naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on or in the vicinity.
  - Avoid heat, direct sunlight and exposure to rain or water. The equipment shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing.
2. Connect the antenna cable or cable TV cable to the **ANT IN** aerial socket on the back of the TV set.
  3. Remote control:  
Remove the cover of the battery compartment. Insert 2 batteries (Type AAA 1.5V).



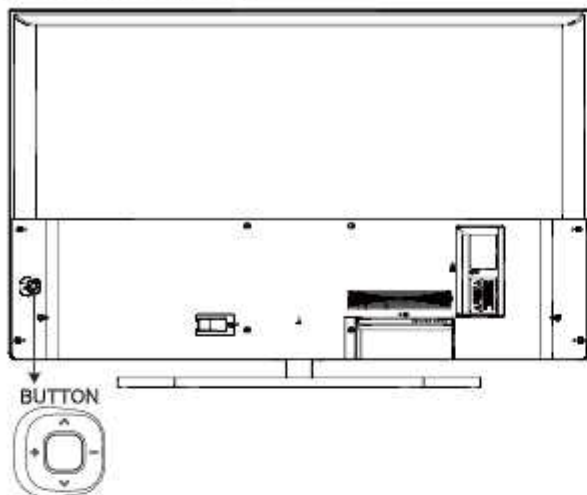
4. Power:  
Plug the cord into a working power outlet.



5. Turn the TV on:  
Press  on the remote control or **POWER** button on the side control panel of the TV.

# PERIPHERAL CONNECTION AND CONTROLS

## BUTTON CONTROL



### Middle key

In the standby mode, press the middle button to turn on the TV.  
In the boot state, long press the middle button to shut down.  
Under the menu page, function equivalent to the OK key.

### Left and right keys

In the non-menu page, press the left and right keys to adjust the volume addition and subtraction.

### Up and down keys

In the non-menu page, you can adjust the TV channel under the program addition and subtraction;  
Under the menu page, you can move the cursor up and down.

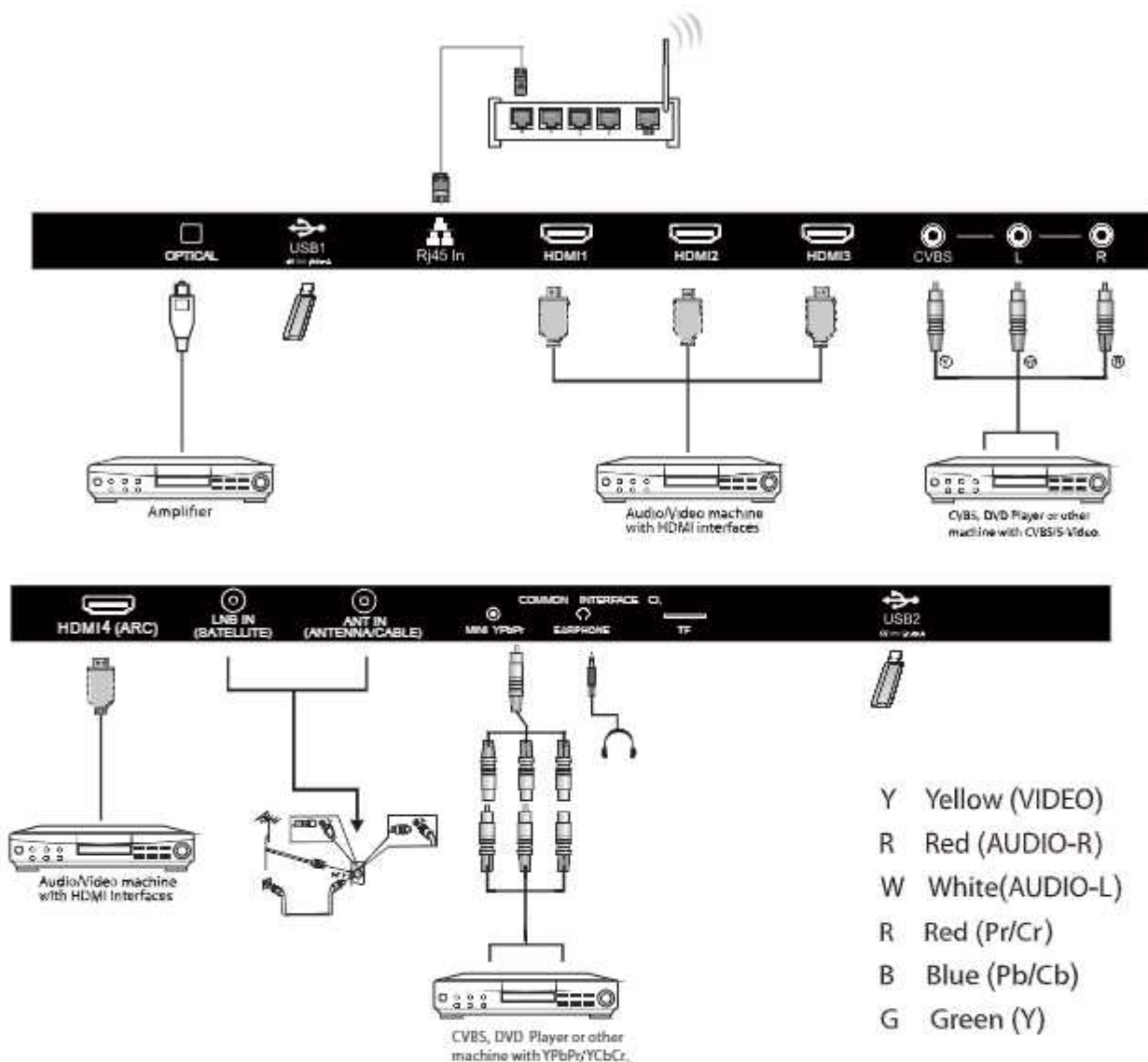

# MAKING CONNECTIONS

  4. USB: Connect USB device.
  5. HDMI: Connect to High-definition multimedia signal resource.
  6. AV INPUT: Video input/Audio input.
- Note: Video And YPbPr share one audio channel.

This function is used for the remote control pair code. After the code is successful, you can use the Bluetooth remote control to operate the TV.



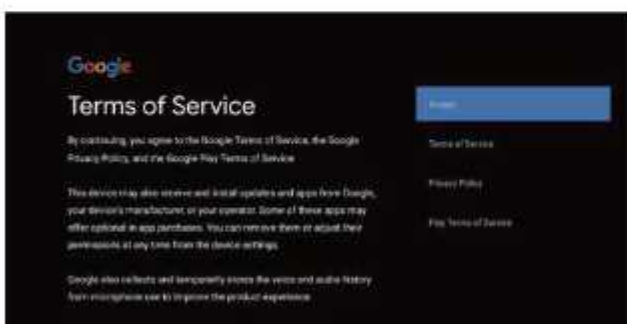
Press ▲/▼ to select the system language and press OK to confirm the language.



Connect your Android phone to your TV, select "Continue" to continue the connection, and choose "Skip" to skip this step.



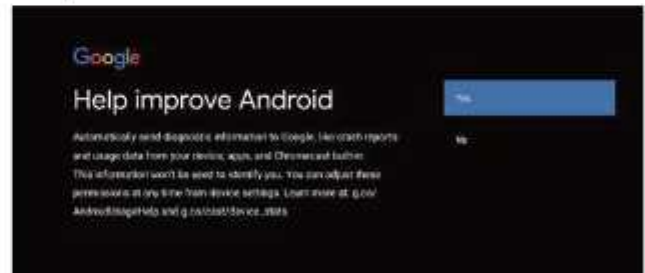
Press ▲/▼ to select the wifi to connect, press OK and enter the password to confirm the connection is successful.

Agree to Google to get the location information of your device to get more features, choose "YES" to accept.



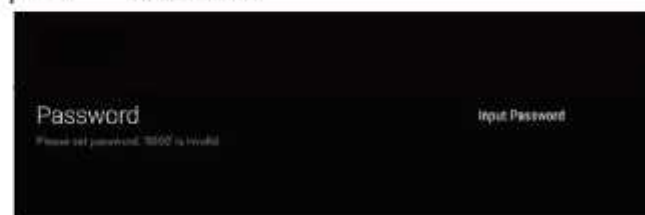

**Single RF Scan:** DTV manual search, left and right after selecting RF Channel, directly OK search.

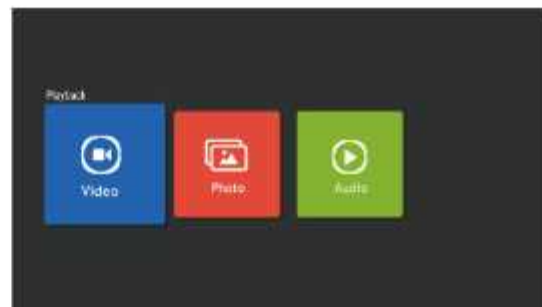
In this menu, you can pair Bluetooth devices.
